<p>I. BAPTISM OF ISRAEL (1 Corinthians 10)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 1500 years before Christ 2. Administrator: The Lord 3. Elements: Cloud & Sea 4. Subjects: Israelites 5. Design: Their deliverance <p>1 Cor. 10:1-4—For I would not, brethren, have you ignorant, that our fathers were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; 2 and were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; 3 and did all eat the same spiritual food; 4 and did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of a spiritual rock that followed them: and the rock was Christ.</p>	<p>IV. THE BAPTISM OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (Acts 1—2)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Promise to the apostles 2. Administrator: Christ 3. Element: The Holy Spirit 4. Subjects: Apostles & Cornelius 5. Design: Qualify them <p>Mark 1:8—I baptized you in water; But he shall baptize you in the Holy Spirit.</p>
<p>II. BAPTISM OF JOHN (Matthew 3)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. John’s mission— “prepare the way.” 2. Administrator: John the Baptizer 3. Element: Water 4. Subjects: penitent Jews 5. Design: Prepare people for Christ <p>Mark 1:3-5—The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Make ye ready the way of the Lord, Make his paths straight; 4 John came, who baptized in the wilderness and preached the baptism of repentance unto remission of sins. 5 And there went out unto him all the country of Judaea, and all they of Jerusalem; And they were baptized of him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins.</p>	<p>V. BAPTISM OF THE GREAT COMMISSION (Matt. 28)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. World wide command 2. Administrators: Christ’s disciples 3. Element: Water 4. Subjects: penitent believers 5. Design: Forgiveness of sins <p>Matt 28:19-20—Go ye therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit: 20 teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.</p>
<p>III. BAPTISM OF SUFFERING (Luke 12:50)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Link in your redemption 2. Administrators: Evil men; enemies of cross 3. Element: Intense suffering 4. Subjects: Christ, apostles, and Christians 5. Design: To perfect faith <p>Mark 10:38-39—But Jesus said unto them, Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able to drink the cup that I drink? or to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? 39 And they said unto him, We are able. And Jesus said unto them, The cup that I drink ye shall drink; and with the baptism that I am baptized withal shall ye be baptized:</p>	<p>VI. BAPTISM OF FIRE (Matthew 3)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Warning to sinners 2. Administrator: Christ 3. Element: Unquenchable fire 4. Subjects: wicked 5. Design: Punishment <p>Matt 3:11-12—I indeed baptize you in water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you in the Holy Spirit and (in) fire: 12 whose fan is in his hand, and he will thoroughly cleanse his threshing-floor; and he will gather his wheat into the garner, but the chaff he will burn up with unquenchable fire.</p>
